Kristy was a wardrobe stylist in Southern California for 15 years. Born with multiple birth defects she became addicted to opioids as a child. After nearly 10 years of sobriety Kristy relapsed and went to federal prison. As a first-time offender she was sentenced to 60 months. Because of her medical issues she was not camp eligible and spent most of her time in a high security federal medical center in Texas. This unique and devastating experience has transformed the way she thrives in the world and is always reminding others how powerful they are to bring about change, in themselves and the community around them. Kristy now works with legislators to remove barriers to successful reentry, passed SB 713 in 2020 and is passionate about bridging communities and cultures through real conversations.

Released in 2017, she lives in New Orleans and graduated summa cum laude with a BS in Innovation and Leadership from Southern Oregon University.

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
